Fly Fishing for Musky – **Capt Brian Meszaros**

Capt Brian presents one of the greatest fly fishing target species in the world as recognized in the industry. During this interactive presentation, you will find the focus on tactics and techniques utilized in the pursuit of this species as well as a discussion on recent environmental issues. A considerable amount of effort must be put forth to landing one of these behemoths; however, it will truly be an experience you will never forget!

Intro to Handcrafting Bamboo Fly Rods – **Jerry Snider**

It has been estimated there may be as many as 132 steps involved in the construction of a split cane bamboo fly rod. For the 1st time bamboo rod builder it may take up to 70 hrs to complete their 1st rod. This presentation is geared for the 1st time bamboo rod builder and will discuss the basic tools required and the major stages involved in split cane bamboo fly rod construction. Stages will include culm selection, flaming, splitting, node preparation, strip straightening, rough beveling, heat treatment, final planing, glue up of planed strips, attaching hardware and varnishing blanks.

Kayak Fish'n in the Bluegrass State– **Allison Depenbrock**

Nathan will cover kayak fly fishing in the State of Kentucky. This presentation will educate you on what kind of kayaks work best for kayak fishing, as well as how to rig them. It will also go over the best places in the state to take your new kayak for fishing.

Nathan has paddled a canoe on everything from flat lakes to adrenaline pumping whitewater rivers. Nathan is also an avid outdoorsman, spending time in the deer and turkey woods, and a lot of his summers on the streams of Kentucky. He is one of the owners of Canoe Kentucky.

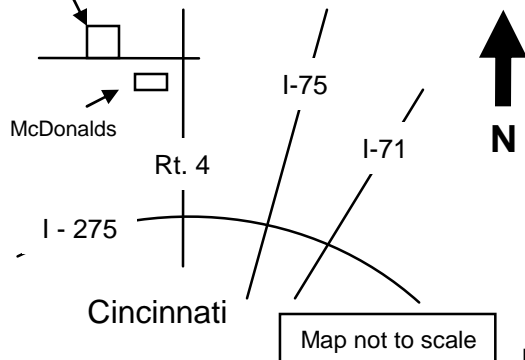
