## Special Raffle Information

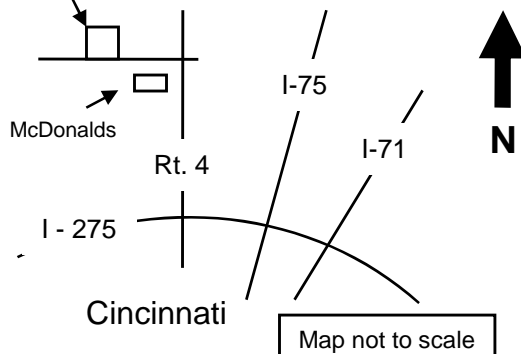
