



Cumberland Worm

You will need to get a toy Stretchy Centipede – available from The Dollar Tree (about 10 inches long with 75 legs), a more expensive model has been seen at Cracker Barrel.

Hook: size 10 streamer
Bead: size 5/32, any color
Thread: red or color to match worm
Body: centipede leg
Super Glue

Slide the bead on the hook and make several thread wraps to hold it in place.
Push the hook through the centipede leg.
Glue the worm in place using Super Glue (important to do or body will slide off hook).

Comments: I was shown a version of this fly while cutting fins at Wolf Creek National Fish Hatchery. I prefer pink legs. This is a great fly if you want to catch bluegills.
