



Damsel Fly

Materials listed in the order used in tying the fly.

Hook: Mustad size 14 dry fly hook (or similar)

Thread: black 6/0

Body: small blue foam body (Orvis), 25 mm total length, tied in behind hook eye so that 6mm extends forward over eye

Wing: black parachute post material (or similar, e.g., white post material marked with a black Sharpie), total width of wing is 24 mm, tied down in center, then the 6 mm of foam body is pulled back and tied down behind the wing material

Mark body using a black permanent marker (Sharpie or similar)

Comments: fish on a 7 ½ ft 5X leader

Species caught: bluegills, largemouth bass
